

Superior Curling Club Bartender

Primary tasks

- Serve beverages to customers during events such as bonspiels and learn to curl events
- Follow all state and local laws regarding sales of alcoholic beverages including the following.
 - Make sure anyone served alcoholic beverages is at least 21 years of age.
 - Do not allow anyone under the age of 21 into the bar area.
 - Do not serve alcoholic beverages to anyone who is intoxicated.
 - Never pour any substance into a liquor bottle (even if it is the same brand).
 - All empty liquor bottles must have the label defaced and placed into the recycle bin.
- Collect the proper payment or keep track of sales for single source payment of all beverages.
- Restock beer cooler as needed.
- Make sure ice water is available for self service at all times.
- Keep the bar area clean and tidy.
- Follow all state and local laws regarding sales of alcoholic beverages.

Requirements

- It is highly recommended that all bartenders hold a valid tavern operator license issued by the City of Superior. If someone is tending bar that does not have a current tavern operator license, they must be supervised by someone who does hold a license.
- Anyone tending bar should be familiar with SCC beverage pricing, know where to find various beverages. It is not necessary to know how to make different types of drinks as they can always ask the customer how to make the drink they are asking for.

Compensation for this position for a licensed bartender is Dollars for Doers OR tips. Bartenders without a license will only receive Dollars for Doers.
