

## **Superior Curling Club Bonspiel Ice Lead**

The primary task is to lead the efforts to prepare and maintain the ice for bonspiel play as follows

- Prior to the first draw of the day and mid-day if appropriate
  - Run the scraper using a specified pattern
  - Properly clean and store the scraper when done
  - Direct others to assist by sweeping up frost in a safe and efficient manner
  - Make sure ice is pebbled and nipped
- Between games
  - Make sure sheets are swept, pebbled and nipped
  - Check supplies such as kleenex and candy, refill as needed
  - Empty garbage cans as needed
- Monitor ice conditions throughout the day and make adjustments if needed to maintain excellent curling ice.

The bonspiel ice lead will need to be trained and be proficient in running the scraper, pebbling, and nipping.

Compensation for the bonspiel ice lead is \$100 per half day. Four or fewer draws with pebbling between games (some bonspiels may not have pebbling between all games) is one-half day. Five or more draws with pebbling between games is a full day. It is expected that there will be one scrape for each half day. There is only one bonspiel ice lead at a time. Other helpers will receive Dollars for Doers
