

Superior Curling Club Head Ice Technician

Primary tasks

- Oversee all aspects of the ice, ice area and mechanicals at the club.
- Coordinates and ensures ice is prepared for all leagues, bonspiels and events as needed, and plans ice-making activities around scheduled events.
- Coordinates the Ice crew schedule.
- Coordinates Ice-in and Ice-out at the beginning and end of season respectively.
- Is the primary point of contact for abnormal ice conditions. Either responds to problems with the ice plant or finds someone to respond.
- Coordinates outside vendors for repairs and or maintenance of compressors and related items, procuring of ice supplies, annual blade sharpening, etc.
- Coordinates Training of Ice crew and club members on ice prep and ice maintenance as needed.
- Help promote ice safety and rules and etiquette of curling
- Stays up to date with annual SafeSport training.

Expertise/training requirements

- Completed Level 1 Ice making course.
- This role requires good leadership, communication and critical thinking skills.

Compensation for the head ice maker is \$5,000 per year. In addition, the head ice maker will earn compensation for being league ice technician and bonspiel ice lead as appropriate.
