

Superior Curling Club League Ice Technician

The primary task is to lead the efforts to prepare the ice prior to league play as follows

- Run the scraper using a specified pattern
- Properly clean and store the scraper when done
- Direct others to assist by sweeping up frost in a safe and efficient manner
- Make sure ice is pebbled and nipped

League ice technicians will need to be trained and be proficient in running the scraper, pebbling, and nipping.

Each league will have up to two ice technicians (one may be an assistant) who will make sure that the ice is prepped every week ahead of league play. If necessary, this may involve asking someone to fill in for them if they can't be there every week.

Compensation for this position is \$300 per year and the option of having no late games scheduled for the corresponding league.

League Ice technicians may also serve as a Bonspiel Ice Lead, which pays an additional \$100 per half day. Four or fewer draws with pebbling between games is one-half day. Five or more draws with pebbling between draws is a full day. It is expected that there will be one scrape for each half day.
