Curling

- All main event games are eight ends. All other games are six ends (if you lose a game, all remaining games are six ends). The free guard zone rule is in effect for the first five rocks.
- In the event of a tie after the allotted number of ends, one person from each team will throw a rock (sweeping for the throwing team only is allowed). Closest rock to the center wins. Ties in the finals will be settled with a full extra end.
- Be sure to grab your envelope from the clubhouse end of the ice if you win one of your first two games.

Etiquette

- The clubhouse sees heavy traffic during bonspiels. To ensure room for socializing, please use the locker rooms and the coat room for your jacket, street shoes, and curling equipment.
- The schedule is dependent on games finishing in a timely manner. Do your best to keep your game from taking too long.
- After your game, be sure to spend time socializing with your opponents.

- We will have a raffle Saturday night before the last games. Purchase your tickets any time and select which prizes you would like to win and drop your tickets into the corresponding bag. You do **NOT** need to be present to win the raffle.
